In case of an emergency involving the above-named child, I understand that every effort will be made to contact the parent or individual listed as the emergency contact person. In the event that this person cannot be reached, permission is hereby given to the medical provider selected by TCDC to secure proper treatment, including hospitalization, anesthesia, surgery, or injections of medication for such child. In the case of emergency, TCDC is authorized to disclose protected/confidential health information ("PHI/CHI") as it deems reasonably necessary to any physician and/or healthcare provider involved in providing medical care to the child. PHI under the Standards for Privacy of Individual Identifiable Health Information, 45 C.F.R. §§160.103, 164.501, et. seq., as amended from time to time, includes examination findings, test results, and treatment provided for purposes of medical evaluation of the child, follow-up and communication with such child's parents or guardian, and/or determination of the child's ability to continue in TCDC activities. I also authorize release of any and all hospital records of any hospital in which treatment is rendered to my child to any insurance company in which the parent, guardian and/or TCDC carries insurance. ## TCDC PROVISIONS REGARDING COVID-19 AND RELATED MATTERS

In-Person TCDC 2021 Camp Session -- TCDC will hold in-person camp from Sunday, June 20, 2021, through Saturday, July 3, 2021, at the Double G Ranch (the "TCDC 2021 Camp Session"). TCDC recognizes that missing any in-person summer camp experience can be difficult for Type 1 campers and their families.

Health and Safety -- **TCDC's PARAMOUNT CONCERN IS THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF ALL TCDC CAMPERS, STAFF, PERSONNEL, AND REPRESENTATIVES** during this period of the coronavirus and its variants ("Covid-19"). **TCDC WILL IMPLEMENT AND ADHERE TO THE TENNESSEE GUIDELINES SET FORTH IN THE [TENNESSEE SUMMER CAMPS, YOUTH CAMP GUIDELINES](#), AND THE [SWIMMING POOL GUIDELINES](#) (specifically regarding outdoor pools) THAT ARE INCORPORATED IN THIS CAMPER APPLICATION BY THIS REFERENCE.** TCDC will also utilize the guidelines of the Diabetes Education & Camping Association. TCDC is subject to the laws and jurisdiction of the State of Tennessee.

Cohorts – The number of people in each cabin will be smaller than in previous years to improve social distancing and reduce the risks associated with Covid-19. TCDC will limit practically all activities to the campers and counselors in each cabin (the "Cohorts"). When more than one Cohort participates in an activity or event, social distancing is strongly encouraged.

Masking Policy – Including medical and kitchen staff, TCDC requires that everyone wears a mask during INDOOR activities from check-in on Sunday, June 20, 2021, through check-out of the last camper on Saturday, July 3, 2021, except while eating, drinking, or sleeping. On Saturday, July 3rd, lasting through check-out of the last camper, masks are required, except while eating or drinking.

TCDC's Right to Cancel -- TCDC retains the right to cancel camp at any time and for any reason, in its sole and absolute discretion, including without limitation, a force majeure. Except as stated in this Camper Application, TCDC shall have neither liability nor financial obligation for cancelling camp.

Force Majeure – Force Majeure is defined in this Camper Application as any act of God, flood, tornado, earthquake, natural catastrophe, fire, explosion, epidemic, pandemic, circumstance relating to Covid-19, quarantine, riot, breakdown of communications, generalized lack of availability of raw materials or energy, any governmental action, or change in any law or regulation.

Prorated Refund -- The Prorated Refund is computed by utilizing the first date of the month in which camp will be held as the start date of camp (the "Start Date") to enable TCDC to recoup some of its expenses. For the TCDC 2021 Camp Session, June 1, 2021, is the Start Date. If TCDC cancels any camp session before the Start Date, the parent(s), legal guardians, and/or any contributor(s) for their respective camper(s) in attendance at the moment of cancellation (the

“Parent”) is entitled to a MAXIMUM REFUND, the paid camp fees (\$850.00) minus the nonrefundable registration fee (\$100.00).

If TCDC cancels any camp session after the Start Date because of a Force Majeure, including without limitation, any circumstance relating to Covid-19, the Parent is entitled to a prorated portion of the paid camp fees (\$850.00) minus the nonrefundable registration fee (\$100.00) (the “Prorated Refund”), payable from Sunday, June 1st – Saturday, June 26th. Beginning Sunday, June 27th, TCDC WILL NOT ISSUE ANY REFUNDS. TCDC has calculated the daily cost of camp per camper to be approximately \$28.85. For clarification, assuming that the Parent has submitted payment in full, a few examples of refunds are the following:

- If TCDC cancels the TCDC 2021 Camp Session prior to the Start Date, TCDC will pay a Maximum Refund in the amount of (\$850.00 paid camp fee - \$100 nonrefundable registration fee) = \$750.00.
- If TCDC cancels the TCDC 2021 Camp Session on Saturday, June 5th, TCDC will pay a Prorated Refund in the amount of (\$850.00 paid camp fee - \$100.00 nonrefundable registration fee) – (5 days \* \$28.85/day) = \$605.75.
- If TCDC cancels the TCDC 2021 Camp Session on Tuesday, June 22nd, TCDC will pay a Prorated Refund in the amount of (\$850.00 paid camp fee - \$100.00 nonrefundable registration fee) – (22 days \* \$28.85/day) = \$115.30.
- If TCDC cancels the TCDC 2021 Camp Session on Monday, June 28th, TCDC will NOT pay any refund.

Rules for TCDC 2021 Camp Session – To protect the TCDC campers, the staff including all medical personnel, counselors, employees, directors, officers, volunteers, agents, successors, and assigns, TCDC has implemented the following Rules for TCDC 2021 Camp Session that TCDC, in its sole and absolute discretion, may change or modify at any time:

1. Camper’s Primary Home Contact -- The Parent of every camper will designate one person to serve as that camper’s primary home contact (the “Camper Contact”) and will provide to TCDC the Camper Contact’s working email, mobile phone number, and text number if different from the mobile number. If a mobile number is not available, a hardline number is required. If anything happens to the Camper Contact, an alternative will be designated to TCDC immediately.
2. Medical History and Examination -- TCDC will contact each Camper Contact to obtain each camper’s medication list and medical history. A completed [Medical](#)

[Examination](#) must be submitted NO LATER THAN **May 15, 2021**. During this time, each family member should monitor temperatures and symptoms daily.

3. [Quarantining Before the TCDC 2021 Camp Session](#) – The Parent of each camper must keep their respective camper quarantined beginning **Sunday, June 14, 2021, for one consecutive week before camp**.
4. [Screening, Testing and Quarantining](#) – During the TCDC 2021 Camp Session, TCDC will follow the State of Tennessee guidelines for screening, testing, and quarantining of all TCDC personnel and campers (any “TCDC Test Taker”). See the [Tennessee Summer Camps, Youth Camp Guidelines](#), and the [Swimming Pool Guidelines](#), referenced in the Health and Safety section.

TCDC will pay the costs of any Covid-19 test for any TCDC Test Taker on or after Sunday, June 20, 2021, and on or before July 3, 2021, at check-out. TCDC is not responsible or liable for any Covid-19 test taken either (a) prior to Sunday, June 20th, (b) on, or (c) after check-out on Saturday, July 3rd.

5. [Notification of the Parent](#) -- TCDC will notify the Parent of any camper who begins to exhibit symptoms for Covid-19. TCDC will notify the Parent of the result of all Covid-19 tests relating to that camper who began to exhibit symptoms.

[Release, Indemnification and Hold Harmless](#) -- The **Tennessee COVID-19 Recovery Act**, signed into law on August 17, 2020, is incorporated herein by this reference. In this Release, Indemnification and Hold Harmless section (the “Indemnification Section”) of the Camper Application for the Tennessee Camp for Diabetic Children, “TCDC” refers to (1) the Double G Ranch, its owners, any heir, devisee, grantee, successor, or assign, and (2) the Tennessee Camp for Diabetic Children, its board members, staff including all medical personnel, counselors, employees, directors, officers, volunteers, agents, successors, and assigns. In this Indemnification Section, the term “Parent” means biological parent, adoptive parent, foster parent, legal guardian, or legal representative of a particular child or children and includes any and all donors, contributors, or payors of TCDC regarding that child or children.

I, the Parent, on behalf of myself, any other parent or guardian of my minor child(ren), and my minor child(ren), understand that use of the TCDC facilities and participation in the TCDC 2021 Camp Session creates a risk of loss, damage, injury, or death (the “Risk”) arising from (a) Covid-19 or (b) a Force Majeure. Furthermore, I, the Parent, have made representations and warranties to TCDC regarding my associated camper(s)’ health, physical contacts, and quarantining.
